(June 2011) The following libraries have been awarded grants by the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) and the American Library Association (ALA) to host “Let’s Talk About It: Making Sense of the American Civil War” reading and discussion series.

Libraries will receive 25 copies of *March* by Geraldine Brooks and *Crossroads of Freedom: Antietam* by James McPherson, 50 copies of a Civil War anthology edited by Edward L. Ayers, as well as a \$3,000 grant from NEH to support program-related expenses, promotional materials, and training for the library project director at a national workshop.
