



IMPACT BY THE NUMBERS FOR MINNESOTA

Grants to Minnesota Organizations and Individuals for Fiscal Year 2019 through 2023 – \$14,768,410

Total Number of Awards – 86

Award Highlights:

- The Hallie Q. Brown Community Center, Inc. received funds from NEH, for the purpose of organizing, moving, and characterizing 22 collections that chronicle the experiences of the African American community in St. Paul, Minn., following the Great Migration.
- Funds were granted to the Minnesota Humanities Center to begin a two-year program of educational and conversational events examining the experiences of underrepresented military service personnel for veterans and other audiences in three Minnesota cities as well as locations in Maine and Mississippi.

NEH also provides annual funding to the [Minnesota Humanities Center Council](#), the designated humanities council in the state, to support a wide array of public programming.

Recent Minnesota Humanities Highlights:

- The MHC conducted The Minnesota Writers series. These series serve to connect writers across the state with people who want to hear more about their stories and their craft. Through this series, they produce, create, and support books and stories that explore a range of subjects.
